Morning Loading Tasks

- Adding specific tasks back into the morning loading process
- Starting hedgers
- Inventory
- Tire Pressure and Mileage checks on trucks
- Etc
- Etc



Sticking Together around the Site

- Keeping tools, supplies, and debris with or ahead of the team at every site helps keep things moving.
- There shouldn't be a trail of things left behind, it should all stay together
- If you need to move more than 5 steps to get to your debris container, it probably is wise to have multiple debris containers.

Water Coolers

- Unpredictable water availability
- In general, pretty gross containers

• Washing and refilling is paid time



Garbage & Recycling

- Refrain from putting loose garbage into the garbage in E24
- Pack ripped debris bags into a whole one in E24
- Stack <u>empty</u> plant containers next to the garbage bin in E24
 - Remove inorganic debris, which can go in the trash
 - Pieces of rock/masonry can go to Eco!
 - Remove organic debris (should happen on site, go in debris bag, pile, or off to Eco)




Personal Belongings

 - Trucks aren't big enough to store your stuff in addition to the crew using it that day.
 - More likely to lose or damage your stuff
- Label your stuff, especially the things we all have one of.
 - Name or initials in your sweatshirt, neck gaiter, kneepads, etc.
 - Use your own color of tape


